Some people looking for space want to be alone, but owners of this traditional style Tulsa home wanted space for their family to be together.

While renovating the house, originally built in 1918, the owners knew exactly what they wanted for their family's kitchen – more seating and more space.

The owners enlisted the help of expert designers and architects Sherri and John Duvall of Duvall Architects as well as builder Tony Jordan of Jordan & Sons to create the space and modern updates they were looking for.

“The new kitchen is located in the addition we built on to the house,” Jordan says of the remodel that doubled the size of the kitchen.

The builders used the portico area to create the new kitchen space and the former kitchen location was then used to add room for the desired extra seating.

Jordan is adamant that home additions shouldn't stand out, but should blend seamlessly with the style of the home.

"The brick for this home is no longer made, but we found an exact match from a demolished building in Chicago and a match for the stone in California," Jordan says.

Creating a more modern aesthetic in the kitchen, the designers used Calcutta marble countertops by EuroCraft and limestone tile backsplash by Ann Sacks.

Overall the space with neutral wall color and light counters was set off by one of the owner's favorite features, the flooring.

"We're just crazy about the charcoal gray porcelain floor tile," the owner says. The flooring, coupled with the custom made walnut cabinetry by Barry Suderman at Woodmasters, complete the feel the owners were looking for.

"I had wanted something else, but once I saw the walnut I fell in love," the owner laughs.

The centerpiece of the kitchen remodel is the array of appliances and amenities.
